Assembly instructions:

1. Unload fibreglass golf holes from the rack with care
2. Locate the nine golf holes in the area designated
3. Locate and fasten the obstacles to each hole, remembering to match the correct obstacle to the numbered hole
4. Erect and install the plastic posts and bunting if on grass
5. Set up table and parasol if required at the entry point with the Putters & balls along with the score cards and pencils

Operating instructions:

1. Operator to supervise and to explain the Rules of the game
2. Operator to issue Putters, Golf Balls, Score Cards and Pencils to all participants
3. Operator to ensure that all participants are playing the game sensibly and in a non aggressive manner I.e. Not hitting the golf balls too hard
4. No more than 4 participants to play any hole at any one time
5. If a competition is being held record the names & scores of all participants
