**Intallation/Removal:**

Wall falling over

Operator

Installation: Operator keeps hold off the wall until the leg is secured to the wall  
 Removal: Operator keeps hold off the wall after the leg has been removed from the wall

**Participation:**

Physical injury due to over stretching

**Most Popular Games**

**60 Second Game**

1. Strike target ' 1 ' then ' E ' starts 60 second game
2. To restart a new 60 second game strike ' 1 ' then ' E ' again.
3. To return to the main menu press the **reset button under the middle arm.**

**30 Second Game**

1. Strike target ' 2 ' then ' 6 ' (they will light up ). Then strike 'E' to start 30 second game
2. To restart a new game just strike ' E '.**this only apply's to this game**
3. To return to the main menu press the **reset button under the middle arm.**

**Exhibition Mode (choice of 4 games)**

To enter exhibition mode press button no."3" then no."2" (they will light up) then press "E" all 3 lights will go out.

**Choice of games in Exhibition mode**

For 30 Second games press button "0" for infant, "4" for Junior or "8" for Senior  
 After games finish to restart any of the above game press the required number

For 60 second game press button "1" for Senior The game will then start.

### Assembly instructions:

1. Stand wall upright leaving bottom protection pipe on and secure leg to top bracket on wall with nut & bolt, then lift wall up & secure bottom bracket to leg with nut & bolt. Making sure that the legs are the correct way round i.e.. Feet with rubber studs are sat on floor. Repeat procedure with other leg on other side.
2. MAKE SURE AC POWER SUPPLY IS SWITCHED OFF. Connect Batak lead to bottom left handside of wall or rear centre panel and run any extra leads as required and fix down accordingly.
3. WHEN REMOVING POWER LEAD SWITCH OF AC POWER SUPPLY FIRST THEN REMEMBER TO PUSH IN THE RED LOCKING TAB BEFORE PULLING OUT THE JACK PLUG
4. Check all functions are working
5. Reset button is under middle arm. Or rear of centre panel on new batak.
6. **To change a bulb please note that the bulb will fit in holder two ways if bulb does not light up turn bulb 180 degrees & refit.**

### Operating instructions:

1. Operator to supervise and explain instructions at all times
  2. Operator is to ensure all participants are playing the game sensibly and in a none aggressive manner, i.e. not hitting buttons to hard
  3. Operator to select programmes for participants
  4. Press the target no. corresponding to the required routine or work out which will be displayed on the central LCD. The target will illuminate and a short Beep will be heard confirming the selection. Any special instructions requirement for input parameters before a routine can be started are shown on the LCD. If an **error** is made on the program selection then press the lower hash target (#) and re-enter. Pressing the (E) or see " Exhibition mode" target will now start play the chosen routine normally starting with the audio response ' Get Ready'. All scoring & timing information is displayed during the workout and special verbal announcements (eg.' Timeout' or 'Now rest') are made as required. If an error is made or the wrong routine started then press the reset button on the underside of the central upright.
- Remember** Batak Pro is a reaction, co-ordination and stamina machine - **ONLY** a modest target strike is required.
