#### **PACKING AWAY**

<u>Always</u> ensure curly lead/cable is put in bag with the horse head.

Failure to do so will result in damage being caused to the leads & heads.

## Assembly instructions:

- 1. Gently place unit on its side, and unfold legs and lock.
- 2. Lift back onto legs.
- 3. Remove top & gently unfold skirt remembering how to fold neatly back in at end.
- 4. Place Horse rail in best position for venue & safety of Equipment/Client
- 5. Lay coloured hobby Horses on horse rail & plug into matching colour socket
- 6. Place coloured race horse into correct wire slots starting from front of table, Blue, yellow, red & then green
- 7. On & Off switch on top of track next to speaker

## **Operating instructions:**

- 1. Riders & spectators to be kept off and away from track
  (No drinks or objects on track)Spectators at least 2m behind players
- 2. Riders to stand astride hobby horse and hold onto handles on side of head.
- 3. Operator to start game when riders in correct position.ie heads away from stand.
- 4. Riders to shake hobby horse up & down as quick as possible Faster they shake horse the quicker the horse moves across the track
- 5. When winner crosses the finish line 'Fanfair' is sounded, replace horses **CAREFULLY** on stand
- 6. Operator to switch off game, horses will return to start.
