Lifting the Neuron Race	Operator	Lift appropriately, bend hips and knees, keep it close to the body Do not twist or turn whilst lifting/moving
Electric shock	Operator	Electrical units are visually inspected for obvious faults, fused Ext. cables are used and equipment is P.A.T. tested once a year
Trip Hazard	Participants	All extension leads are taped down or not over walk ways.

## Assembly instructions:

1. Unfold staging legs, place stage on top & lock onto legs with alan key
2. Lift/Push Neuron Race whilst in flight case onto staging  
Two people: lift it on, carefully  
One person barrows up to the staging, lean the flight case against the staging, go to the bottom handles lift and push onto the top.
3. Remove lid of the flight case
4. Ensure power lead is securely in place and not squashed.
5. Tape down power lead if it is a trip hazard.

## Operating extensions:

1. Two Players at a time
2. Explain how you have 30s to 'tap' out as many lit up lights as possible - you score 1 point each time. If you tap an unlit light - you lose 1 point each time.
3. Press the middle button.
4. The lights on the top will count them in.
5. At the end of 30s declare who is the winner!
