**EXISTING CONTROLS covered by information held**

**Operators are instructed to tell participant to walk slowly forward off the inflatable.**  
 Operators are instructed to only allow one participant on the inflatable at once  
 Operators are instructed to segregate older stronger participants from younger less active ones  
 Inflatable to have a shooting area free from non-participants  
**Ensure participants do not trip over guide ropes.**  
 Operators to site inflatable away from naked flames and forbid smoking on and around the inflatable  
 When on grass the inflatable is always pegged, if on concrete adequate sandbags are used to prevent movement  
 Operators are instructed to site inflatable so there is minimum access behind  
 Electrical units are visually inspected for obvious faults, fused Ext. cables are used and equipment is P.A.T. tested once a year  
 On Grass Check type of soil type under grass - clay has a lot stronger hold than sand  
 Securely double peg all anchor points into the ground.  
 On Hard Standing All supplied weights to be used and anchor to fixed objects if required.  
 If wind speed exceeds 35km/h on windometer or if guideropes or pegs start to move in start to move in the ground or weights start to move when in use, immediately evacuate & deflate until wind has dropped and operator deems appropriate to re-start.

### Assembly Instructions

1. Lay out ground sheet if required
  2. Unroll inflatable
  3. Attach blower to inflatable and zip vent shut.
  4. Switch on fan & assist upper section of the inflatable into position.
  5. Once inflatable is inflated anchor it down, in windy conditions its wise to peg the base loosely before inflation - then re-peg once fully inflated.
  6. Peg the guide ropes at 45 degrees forward to the base inflatable, back guide ropes to be used at all times.
  7. If on concrete attach guide ropes to loops on side of base inflatable and attach sandbags
- 812/12/2014 Crash mats to cover all open sides

### Operator Instructions

1. Only one keeper on the inflatable at one time
2. Only have one ball in use, keep the others out of sight and use only for a spare
- 3. The inflatable/bed platform to the rear of the inflatable is not to be bounced on or played on in any manner what so ever this area is clearly labelled**
4. No shoes, food, drink, cigarettes or sharp objects to taken onto the inflatable
5. Rear of inflatable must have clear area ie. No windows behind as ball comes through circles cutout in rear wall
