GROUPS AT RISK

EXISTING CONTROLS covered by information held

Blower/Power Failure	Participants	Operators are instructed to tell participants to remain exactly where they are until the problem is resolved or the inflatable becomes safe to walk off.
Overloading	Participants	Operators are instructed to only allow two participants on the inflatable at once
Injury caused by boisterous behaviour	Participants	Operators are instructed to segregate older more lively participants from younger less active ones
Collision when exiting the inflatable	Participants Crowd	Inflatable to have an appropriate crowd barrier at a safe distance from the inflatable
Fire	Participants Crowd/Operator	Operators to site inflatable away from naked flames and forbid smoking on and around the inflatable
Inflatable tipping over	Participants Crowd	When on grass the inflatable is always pegged, if on concrete adequate sandbags are used to prevent movement
Injury from feudal sticks	Participants	Operators to ensure that participants always wear a head guard. Operators instructed to ensure participants always hold peudal poles with both hands by the webbing loops.
Electric shock	Operator	Electrical units are visually inspected for obvious faults, fused Ext. cables are used and equipment is P.A.T. tested once a year
Unsafe Behaviour	Participants	Operators only allow participants on who are not obviously under the influence of alcohol. The game would be stopped if the behaviour of anyone jeopardised the safety of the participants or of the crowd around.
Excessive Wind	Participant: On Grass Crowd On Hard Standing	Check type of soil type under grass - clay has a lot stronger hold than sand Securely double peg all anchor points into the ground. All supplied weights to be used and anchor to fixed objects if required. If wind speed exceeds 35km/h on windometer or if guide rope pegs start to move in the ground or weights start to move when in use, immediately evacuate & deflate until wind has dropped and operator deems appropriate to re-start.

Assembly Instructions

1. Place ground sheet down on required area
2. Unroll inflatable, close 6 deflation zips, & tie inflation tube to the blower
3. Ensure there is at least 2 feet clearance all the way round the inflatable from people and objects
4. Anchor inflatable with pegs or sandbags.

6. Place padded poles, helmets & neck guards on inflatable
7. Place crash mat at entrance.

Operator Instructions

1. Ensure helmets & neck guards are securely on
2. Ensure participants hold the pole with both hands
3. Act as a referee
4. Ensure only 2 participants are on the inflatable at any time, jousting only when on the podiums
5. Each game is over when the 1st person falls off
6. No shoes allowed on the inflatable
7. No food, drink, cigarettes or sharp objects to allowed on the inflatable
