Electrical units are visually inspected for obvious faults, fused Ext. cables are used and equipment is P.A.T. tested once a year

All extension leads are taped down or not over walk ways.

Operator to ensure legs are 'locked' before play commences.

Assembly instructions:

1. Gently place unit on its side, and unfold legs and lock.
2. Lift back onto legs.
3. Remove top & gently unfold skirt - remembering how to fold neatly back in at end.
4. Place all body parts in respective holes.

Tennis Elbow

Adams Apple (Neck)

Water on the knee (bucket)

Heart

Funnybone (elbow)

Tendons (elastic bands)

5. Plug in tweezers and power lead and tape down extension lead.

Plug in power supply and check that it is set on 12v

Operating extensions:

1. When the player is ready press the red button
2. The player has 3 lives and every time the tweezers touch the body you loose a life.
3. On the 1st touch of the body you will hear "Ow be careful"
On the 2nd touch "Touch that and I'll call my layer"
3rd time you will be greeted with an ambulance siren and the timer stops
4. The timer will record exactly how many seconds it takes to remove all ten body parts and then press the button or until you have lost all lives and the siren sounds
5. The player removes all ten in the quickest time is the winner.
