Injury caused by boisterous behaviour	Participants	Operators are instructed to segregate older more lively participants from younger less active ones

Assembly Instructions

1. Position Inflatable where required making sure that the moles are in the tunnels
2. Place and Velcro fan in side of inflatable, metal grill facing the outside plug in and inflate
3. Gafa Tape down Electric cable if indoors
4. Check moles are sliding up & down the tunnels.
5. When rolling up inflatable remove fan & **make sure moles are laid flat and not folded i**
- 6. Rap inflatable in bag**
